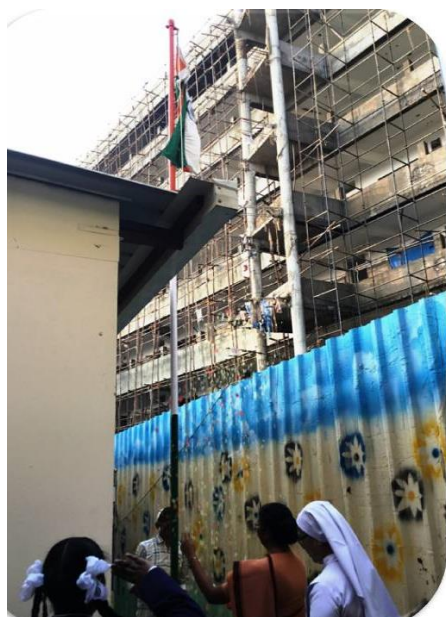
## KG Wild Animal Activity

## Republic Day Celebrations

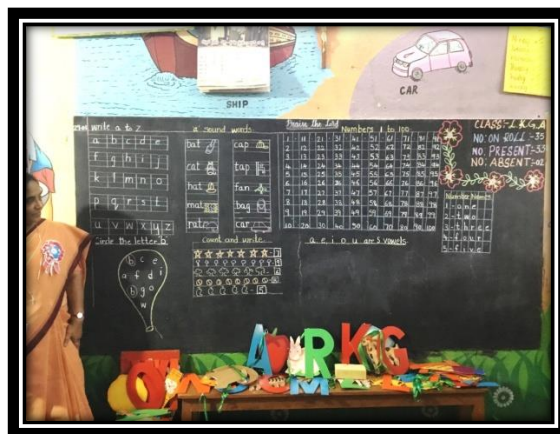
